

We are undertaking important investigations to help us understand the local ground conditions and plan for Marinus Link's underground cable.

From Wednesday, 7 August to Friday, 9 August 2024 you may see activity along our proposed cable alignment on roadsides between Hazelwood and Buffalo.

Our geotechnical investigations will look at soil properties, ground water and other geological conditions. This will help us to understand design requirements for the project.

## WHAT YOU MAY SEE:

- Site setups, some single-lane closures and traffic management on local roads.
- $\diamond$  Project support vehicles, including trucks transporting an excavator and drilling rig.
- Specialist consultants and equipment undertaking investigation activities.



### Things to note:

- All necessary approvals, permits and access agreements will be in place.
- Work sites will be no louder than a small working excavator.
- Work sites will be reinstated when complete.
- This work is not the beginning of construction activities.



# **BACKCROUND**

Marinus Link is a proposed undersea and underground electricity and telecommunications interconnector between North West Tasmania and the Latrobe Valley in Victoria.

The project comprises high voltage direct current (HVDC) cables, fibre optic cables, and converter stations in both Tasmania and Victoria. The converter stations will connect Marinus Link directly into the transmission networks in both Tasmania and Victoria.

The project's cables span 345 kilometres (km). This includes 255 km of undersea cables across Bass Strait and 90 km of underground cables in Cippsland, Victoria.


